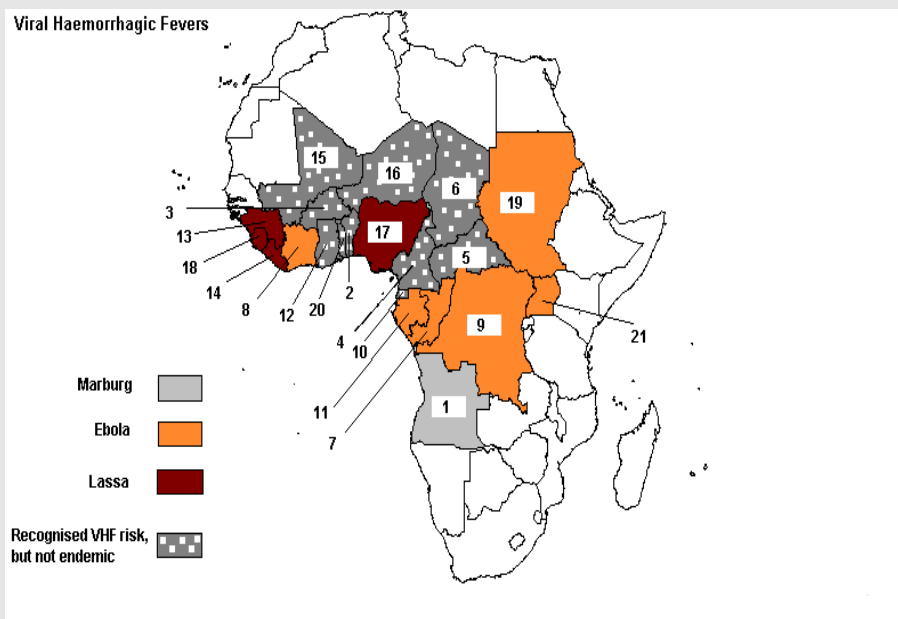


Rural African Risk Assessment Form
